

Requirements for the Final Projects of the Course Human Computer Interaction, Spring 2013

For the final project check, you are required to give a twenty-minute presentation on your work to the whole class on **June 20**. In the presentation, the following parts should be included, key ideas of the work, system structure design, key technologies used in your implementation, final results, and some novel ideas to improve or extend in the further work. Moreover, each student is expected to attend the presentation and provide a description of her/his own contributions to the project. Before the presentation, each team should submit the PPT and codes of the project to TA, while the other items can be handed in later. Here are the deadlines and essential items to be submitted at each stage.

Deadline - June 20

- **Source Codes** - Source codes should be with necessary comments.
- **Executable Program** – The entire executable program and any external library which it depends on should be included.
- **PPT of the Presentation**

Deadline - June 30

- **Final Report** - Submit a readable and well-organized report that provides proper motivation for the task, proper explanation of the details of the approach and implementation strategies, and so on. You should use the IEEE conference format when writing your final report. (http://www.ieee.org/conferences_events/conferences/publishing/templates.html)
- **Project Document** - The project document should explain the way to build, run and developing environment of your application.
- **Poster** - Please design a poster in E-edition to introduce your project, and it should be in size of A1 (841mm × 594mm, 150 dpi). Both editable file (e.g. PSD) and final picture (e.g. JPG, PNG) are required.

Please package all your files into a RAR or ZIP file which name is composed of your project name and date (e.g. name_20130620), and send it to the TA of this course (gary.zhao9012@gmail.com). All the documents handed in should be in English.
